

Rosemary, Sage and Lavender Air Freshener and Linen spray

This is an invigorating and floral air freshener – not sickly or fake-smelling, more like your nana’s garden in spring. Rosemary and lavender go perfectly together. You can mix and match your smells using any herbs and flowers you have in your garden. Hard herbs work best. Makes 500ml

- 2 sprigs rosemary
- 1 sprig sage
- 1 sprig lavender
- 1 lemon, sliced
- 500ml water
- 6 drops essential oil (for extra oomph)
- a 500ml spray bottle (recycled one is fine)
- extra sprigs for decorating
- essential oils if you have them

Put all the ingredients into a small saucepan. Bring to a simmer over a medium heat, cover, and let it simmer a further 5 minutes. Cool and pour into a spray bottle – no need to strain the ingredients as they will continue to infuse in the bottle, you can remove if you prefer. If the sprigs are too tall for the bottle just break them in half and you can also twist the lemon slices and add them at the end, fresh, if you prefer.

This is not a strong smelling spray so if you want a little more punch add some essential oil.
